KEYS Family Support

Is a free service for parents and carers living within the Kwinana and Rockingham communities with children aged between 0 - 12 years.

Family Support Workers assist with:

- ◆ Home-based, on-site case management for family assistance
- ◆ Developing and enhancing family relationships
- ◆ Enhancing social and life skills
- ◆ Family support around child behaviour
- ◆ Empowering families to achieve positive life outcomes
- ◆ Information and referral pathways to appropriate services including other KEYS programs
- ◆ Families experiencing domestic violence/ homelessness and financial problems
- ◆ Transport assistance with prior arrangement

KEYS work from a non-judgemental, strength based perspective. We welcome Aboriginal families, families from other cultural backgrounds and grandparents raising their grandchildren.

The Family Support Worker is bound by an 'Oath of Confidentiality' in relation to family support sessions. Confidentiality may be waived when there is a threat or risk to an individual's safety.
